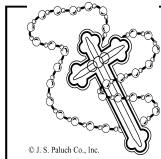

**La Ascensión del Señor
28 de mayo de 2017**



*Se fue elevando a la vista de ellos,
hasta que una nube lo ocultó a sus ojos.*

— Hechos 1:9

Entre voces de júbilo y trompetas, Dios el Señor asciende hasta su trono.

(Salmo. 47 (46))

Nos encontramos ya, en el séptimo domingo de pascua, un domingo más en el que recordamos la presencia salvífica de Jesús. Las lecturas de hoy nos ofrecen una consideración teológica de gran densidad: el triunfo de Jesús, después de haber cumplido con valentía y generosidad la misión que le había encomendado Dios.



La fiesta de hoy nos debe comunicar a los cristianos un sincero sentido de fiesta pascual, porque nosotros también somos partícipes de la victoria de Jesús y estamos llamados a la vida definitiva con él. El motivo fundamental es que Cristo ya nos ha incluido de alguna manera en su destino final: “ya desde este mundo nos haces participar de tu vida divina” (oración poscomunión).

Cristo es la Cabeza de la Iglesia: “No se fue para alejarse de nuestra pequeñez, sino para que pusiéramos nuestra esperanza en llegar, como miembros suyos, a donde Él, nuestra cabeza y principio, nos ha precedido”. Cristo es también nuestra victoria, pues a donde llegó él, nuestra cabeza, tenemos la esperanza cierta de llegar nosotros, que somos su cuerpo”.

Es ahí la importancia de esta celebrar la fiesta de la Ascensión del Señor, una fiesta que para nosotros los Cristianos tiene un sentido fundamental en nuestra fe.
