SEND OUT YOUR SPIRIT

Last week we heard that, following the Ascension, the disciples, Mary, and other followers of the Lord retreated to the upper room in prayer. This week we hear that, while praying in that room, the Holy Spirit comes upon them. Jesus' post-Resurrection promise, recounted in today's Gospel, is fulfilled: the power of the Holy Spirit comes upon Jesus' followers. Saint Paul tells us that all of us, in some way, are given gifts of the Holy Spirit, gifts that can be used to spread the Good News. Today is one of the Church's greatest festivals. Let us carry the refrain of the responsorial psalm with us throughout the coming week: "Lord, send out your Spirit, and renew the face of the earth!" (Psalm 104:30).

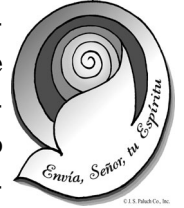
**Domingo de Pentecostés
4 de junio de 2017**



Entonces aparecieron lenguas de fuego, que se distribuyeron y se posaron sobre ellos.

— Hechos 2:3

Pentecostés (ó Domingo de Pentecostés) tiene lugar el 4 de Junio de 2017. En esta fecha se celebra el descenso del Espíritu Santo y el inicio de la actividad de la Iglesia, por ello también se le conoce como la celebración del Espíritu Santo. La solemnidad de Pentecostés es una fiesta móvil, no tiene fecha fija en el calendario, siendo justo 7 semanas después del Domingo de Pascua.



Siete semanas son cincuenta días, de ahí el nombre de “Pentecostés” (=cincuenta) que recibió más tarde. La fiesta de Pentecostés es uno de los domingos más importante del año, después de la Pascua. En el Antiguo Testamento era la fiesta de la cosecha y, posteriormente, los israelitas, la unieron a la Alianza en el Monte Sinaí, cincuenta días después de la salida de Egipto.

En el calendario cristiano con Pentecostés termina el tiempo pascual de los 50 días. Los cincuenta días pascuales y las fiestas de la Ascensión y Pentecostés, forman una unidad. No son fiestas aisladas de acontecimientos ocurridos en el tiempo, son parte de un solo y único misterio.

La fiesta de Pentecostés, es el segundo domingo más importante del año litúrgico en donde los cristianos tienen la oportunidad de vivir intensamente la relación existente entre la Resurrección de Cristo, su Ascensión y la venida del Espíritu Santo.
