**Lenten Regulations**



- + Everyone over 18 and under 59 years of age is bound to **fast on Good Friday**. On a day of fast, only one full meal is allowed; two smaller meals, sufficient to maintain strength, may be taken, but together they should not equal another full meal. Eating between meals is not permitted, but liquids are allowed. When health or ability to work would be seriously affected, the law does not oblige. If in doubt concerning fast or abstinence, a priest should be consulted.
- + Everyone **over 14 years of age** is bound to **abstain from meat on all Fridays** of Lent.
- + During Lent, Catholics are encouraged to **pray more** often. It is the ideal time to receive the sacrament of penance (confession).
- + **Almsgiving**, gifts to charity and to the poor are encouraged as a way of sharing God's gifts to us.

**Reminder: Receiving Communion in the Hand**

Do not walk away with the sacred host. Consume it immediately after the priest or Eucharistic minister places it on your hand. Remember that it is actually the Body of Christ, and should be treated with great reverence! Never take the Eucharist out of the church.



+ **Holy Thursday** Mass of Our Lord's Last Supper at 7 pm in English in the church, and at 7 pm in Spanish in Kavanagh Center. Following both Masses there will be Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament in Kavanagh Center until midnight.

+ **Good Friday** Liturgy begins at 12 noon in English in the church for Stations of the Cross, Rosary and meditation. At 2 pm there will be Veneration of the Cross and Communion. *Spanish services begin at 3 pm in Kavanagh Center.*



+ **Easter Vigil Mass**, which includes baptisms of Catechumens beginning at 8 pm in English in church, and at 8 pm in Spanish in Kavanagh Center.

**NO OTHER MASSES THIS DAY.**

+ **Easter Sunday** Masses are on the regular Sunday schedule: English—7, 9, and 11 am, 1 pm, 5:30, 7:30 pm in the church. *Spanish in Kavanagh Center at 10 am and 12 noon.*

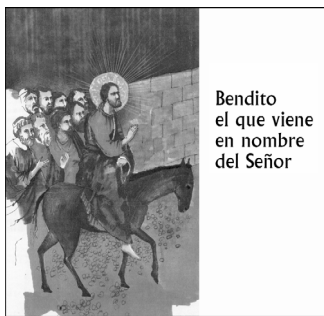
