Holy Week Schedule

+ Holy Thursday Mass of Our Lord's Last Supper at 7 pm in English in the church, and at 7 pm in Spanish in Kavanagh Center. Following both Masses there will be Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament in Kavanagh Center until midnight.

+ Good Friday Liturgy begins at 12 noon at 2 pm in English in church and Veneration of the Cross and Communion at 2 pm. In Spanish services begin at 3 pm in Spanish in Kavanagh Center.

+ Easter Vigil Mass, which includes baptisms of Catechumens beginning at 8 pm in English in church, and at 8 pm in Spanish in Kavanagh Center. No other Masses that day.

+ Easter Sunday Masses are on the regular Sunday schedule.



On the Fridays of Lent, meditation on the Stations of the Cross will be held at 6:30 pm in English in the church, and at 7:00 pm in Spanish in Kavanagh Center.

- + During Lent, Catholics are encouraged to pray more often.** It is the ideal time to receive the sacrament of penance (confession).
- + Almsgiving, gifts to charity and to the poor are encouraged as a way of sharing God's gifts to us.**

SAN JOSÉ, ESPOSO DE LA VIRGEN MARÍA

San José, el Santo custodio de la Sagrada Familia, es el Santo que más cerca está de Jesucristo y de la Santísima Virgen.

San Mateo llama a San José "el hijo de Jacob" (véase San Mateo 1,16). Según San Lucas, "su padre era Elí" (véase San Lucas 3,23).

Probablemente nació en Belén, la ciudad de David, del que era descendiente. Al comienzo de la historia de los Evangelios, poco antes de la Anunciación, San José vivía en Nazareth.

Según San Mateo y San Marcos, San José era un "tekton" (véase San Mateo 13,55; San Marcos 6,3). La palabra significa, en particular, que era carpintero o albañil. San Justino lo confirma, y la tradición ha aceptado esta interpretación.

Nuestro Señor Jesús fue llamado "Hijo de José", "el carpintero" (véase San Juan 1,45; 6,42; San Lucas 4,22).

Como sabemos, no era el padre natural de Cristo, quien fue engendrado en el vientre virginal de la Virgen María por obra del Espíritu Santo, y es Hijo de Dios. Pero, José lo adoptó amorosamente, y Jesús se sometió a él como un buen hijo ante su padre.

¡Cuánto influyó José el desarrollo humano del niño Jesús! ¡Qué perfecta unión existió en su ejemplar matrimonio con María!
