Reminder: Receiving Communion in the Hand

Do not walk away with the sacred host. Consume it immediately after the priest or Eucharistic minister places it on your hand. Remember that it is actually the Body of Christ, and should be treated with great reverence! Never take the Eucharist out of the church.

Famous artifacts from our church, St. Rose, are on display at the Crocker Art Museum thru April 22nd. If you have been coming to St. Rose for

a long time, you may remember the gold-colored crucifix and set of 6 candlesticks with a rose leaf design that were on our altar for decades. They were designed specifically for our church by famous artist, E. Charlton Fortune, commissioned by the McClatchy Family. It turns out that the artist became quite famous and her works are being displayed throughout California. Baptism Instruction Class

“CREER EN JESUCRISTO”

Durante todo el Tiempo Pascual, las tres lecturas del domingo son tomadas del Nuevo Testamento, la parte cristiana de la Sagrada Escritura. Juntas exploran qué significa creer que Jesús es el Cristo, aquél que cumplió las profecías de la Sagrada Escritura judía.

Las selecciones de hoy aluden a nuestra debilidad humana; sin embargo, hacen hincapié en el perdón y la paz que son posibles para quienes tienen fe en “Jesucristo, el Justo” (1 Juan 2:2). En los Hechos de los Apóstoles, Pedro nos dice a todos “arrepíentense y conviértanse, para que se borren sus pecados” (Hechos 3:19). La primera carta del apóstol san Juan dice que Jesucristo es “víctima de expiación por nuestros pecados” (1 Juan 2:2). Por último, en el Evangelio, Jesús saluda a los discípulos diciéndoles: “Paz” y los insta a predicar “la necesidad de volverse a Dios y el perdón de los pecados” (Lucas 24:47).

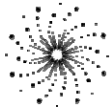
